**D-1 Teams:** 2 riders (D-1 only), one Stable Manager (any D level) and a C or above advisor.  
**D-2 / D-3 Teams:** 3 or 4 riders (D-2 and D-3 only), one Stable Manager (any D level) and a C or above advisor.

C and up advisors may assist no more than 3 teams.

**Dressage Tests:** D-1: USDF 2019 Introductory Test A  
D-2: USDF 2019 Introductory Test C  
D-3: 2022 USEF Beginner Novice Test A

- Jumping:** D-1 stadium jumping course will consist of ground poles (no cross-country)  
D-2 Maximum height 18" for stadium jumping and cross-country  
D-3 Maximum height 2'3" for stadium jumping and cross-country
- Fees:** Entry fee \$62 per rider. No fees for Stable Managers or C and up advisors.
- Payment:** **Check with your club/center on payment policy. Online payment method is preferred!**  
Please pay entry fees online when registering. If you must pay by check, please mail check made out to VRPC to the Treasurer, Steve Vorpahl, at 7482 Argyll Ct. Warrenton VA 20187. Must be postmarked by June 10th.

- Attire:** Polo shirt, riding pants, belt (if pants have belt loops), Pony Club pin, approved helmet and appropriate footwear. Competitors are required to wear their completed USPC medical Form in the medical armbands or USPC approved medical bracelet for the duration of the rally.
- Trailer Rally:** This is a 1 day rally. We ask that teams "trailer pool" to reduce the number of trailers entering the farm. Parking is limited so please consolidate as much as possible. We hope to use the temporary stalls (think big tent with stalls a horse shows) ODHPC has up for their camp. Final decision will be made on if we need to use trailers once all entries are in.
