Teams: Division 1 Junior D, 12 years of age or less, may be unrated, teams of 3-4

Division 2 Senior D, 13 years of age and up, may be unrated, teams of 3-4

Division 3 Junior C/H-B/B, 14 years of age or less, teams of 3-4 Division 4 Senior C/H-B/B, 15 years of age and up, teams of 3-4 Division 5 B/H/H-HM/H-A/A, 14-25 years of age, teams of 2

All ages are as of January 1, 2017. A competitor does not have to meet championships qualifications to compete on a qualifying team. Competitors must be at least a D-2 and 10

years of age to qualify for USPC Championships.

Lunch:

General:

- > Testing phases include Classroom, Written, Mega Room and Stations.
- > Competitors are required to wear an approved medical ID bracelet or their completed USPC Medical Card in their medical armbands for the duration of the rally. In addition, since there is a barn phase competitors are required to wear approved footwear.
- > Only the team captain or appointed designee may pick up registration packets.
- > Food may only be consumed in the Falls Church cafeteria.
- Non-competing children may not attend the rally with chaperones or volunteers.
- > Chaperones must carry the registration packet with them as the team moves through each phase. It is the chaperone's responsibility to ensure that no answer sheet leaves a completed phase with a competitor.
- ➤ Show your team spirit and be creative—we will once again have a team costume contest!

Volunteers: Minimum of two volunteers in addition to one chaperone per team entry is required.

Minimum of one volunteer per two scramble entries is required.
