Dressage Tests: 2018 USEF Beginner Novice Test A

Jumps: Maximum height 2'3" for stadium jumping and cross-country

Fees: Entry fee \$62 per rider ad \$25 for Out of Region members. No fees for Stable Managers or C and up advisors.
