Divisions

Open Preliminary/Training Division

Jumps not to exceed 3'7"

Open Preliminary/Training -Open to all horse and rider combinations currently competing or looking to move up to Preliminary

Dressage: USEF 2018 Prelim Test A. Small Arena

Show Jumping: Show jumping jumps will not exceed 3'7"

Cross Country: **WILL JUMP TRAINING LEVEL XC COURSE.** Approximately 18 - 20 obstacles, 2000 meters at 450 mpm. Timed.

Preliminary Combined Test: Dressage and show jumping same as above; no Cross Country.

Open Modified/Training Division

Jumps not to exceed 3'5"

Open Modified/Training -Open to all horse and rider combinations currently competing or looking to move up to Preliminary

Dressage: USEF 2018 Modified Test A. Small Arena

Show Jumping: Show jumping jumps will not exceed 3'5"

Cross Country: **WILL JUMP TRAINING LEVEL XC COURSE.** Approximately 18 - 20 obstacles, 2000 meters at 450 mpm. Timed.

Modified Combined Test: Dressage and show jumping same as above; no Cross Country.

Open Training & Training Rider Divisions

Jumps not to exceed 3'3"

Open Training -Have completed more than two Horse Trials at Preliminary or higher within the previous 24 months.

Training Rider -Have *not* completed more than two Horse Trials at Preliminary or higher within the previous 24 months.

Dressage: USEF 2018 Training Test A. Small Arena

Cross Country: Approximately 18 - 20 obstacles, 2000 meters at 425 mpm. Timed.

Training Combined Test: Dressage and show jumping same as above; no Cross Country.

Open Novice, Foxhunter Novice & Novice Rider

Jumps not to exceed 2'11"

Open Novice - Have completed more than two Horse Trials at Training or higher within the previous 24 months.

Novice Rider - Have *not* completed more than two Horse Trials at Training or higher within the previous 24 months.

Foxhunter Novice- **MUST** be a current member of a foxhunt, riding the horse that you regularly hunt & not competed hunt horse in a recognized horse trial in the last 12 months.

Dressage: USEF 2018 Novice Test A. Small Arena

Cross Country: Approximately 16 -18 obstacles. Approximately 1800 meters at 350 mpm. Timed.

Novice Combined Test: Dressage and show jumping same as above; no Cross Country.

**Open Beginner Novice, Foxhunter Beginner Novice & Beginner Novice Rider
Jumps not to exceed 2'7"**

Open Beginner Novice-Have completed more than two Horse Trials at Novice or higher within the previous 24 months.

Beginner Novice Rider-Have *not* completed more than two Horse Trials at Novice or higher within previous 24 months.

Foxhunter Beginner Novice- **MUST** be a current member of a foxhunt, riding the horse that you regularly hunt & not competed hunt horse in a recognized horse trial in the last 12 months.

Dressage: USEF 2018 Beginner Novice Test A. Small Arena

Cross Country: Approximately 15 obstacles. Approximately 1500 meters at 300 mpm. Timed.

Beginner Novice Combined Test: Dressage and show jumping same as above; no Cross Country.

**Open Introductory Novice, Introductory Novice Rider & Foxhunter Introductory Novice
Jumps not to exceed 2'**

Open Introductory Novice- Open to horse and rider combinations that have not completed more than two horse trials at the beginner novice level in the last 12 months.

Introductory Novice Rider- Have not completed more than two Horse Trials at Beginner Novice or higher within previous 24 months.

Foxhunter Intro Novice- **MUST** be a current member of a foxhunt, riding the horse that you regularly hunt & not competed hunt horse in a recognized horse trial in the last 12 months.

Dressage: USDF 2019 Intro. Level Test C. Small Arena.

Cross Country: 12 obstacles. Approximately 1500 meters. Not timed.

Introductory Combined Test: Dressage and show jumping same as above; no Cross Country.

**Green Horse Trials & Foxhunter Green.
Jumps not to exceed 2'**

Green Horse Trials- Open to all horses that have not competed in more than 3 horse trials above 18". Great for "green" horses.

Foxhunter Green- **MUST** be a current member of a foxhunt, riding the horse that you regularly hunt & not competed hunt horse in a recognized horse trial in the last 12 months.

Dressage: USDF 2019 Intro. Level Test C. Small Arena.

Cross Country: 8 obstacles. Approximately 1000 meters. Not timed. **XC will be a modified version of the introductory novice course. Horse & rider combinations MUST be able to jump up to but no higher than 2'.**

Show Jumping: Course will be a combination of jumps ranging from 18" to 2'.

**Cross Rails Combined Test & Foxhunter Cross Rails
Jumps not to exceed 18" (NO XC)**

Cross Rails Combined Test: Open to all horse & rider combinations wanting to gain knowledge & experience in the sport of eventing.

Foxhunter Cross Rails- **MUST** be a current member of a foxhunt, riding the horse that you regularly hunt & not competed hunt horse in a recognized horse trial in the last 12 months.

Dressage: USDF 2019 Intro. Level Test B. Small Arena.

**Tadpole & Foxhunter Tadpole.
Jumps are poles on the ground (No XC)**

Tadpole Combined Test- Open to all horse & rider combinations wanting to gain knowledge & experience in the sport of eventing.

Foxhunter Tadpole- **MUST** be a current member of a foxhunt, riding the horse that you regularly hunt & not competed hunt horse in a recognized horse trial in the last 12 months.

Dressage: USDF 2019 Intro. Level Test A. Small Arena.

All divisions will be split junior/senior if entries warrant.

Cross Country Courses

Slightly rolling, mostly open terrain. New and inviting fences at all levels.

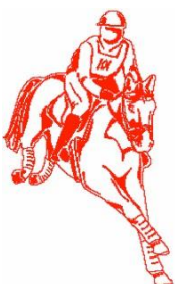
Average difficulty for riders with experience at this level.

General Conditions and Rules

1. There will be six ribbons places per division and six dressage ribbons places per horse trials division.
2. Entries must include full payment, current Coggins test, signed Release, and mailed to the Secretary.
3. No refunds after closing date without veterinary certificate; refunds before closing date minus \$25 office fee.
4. Horses may NOT be entered in more than one level of horse trials competition. Combined tests competitors MAY enter more than one combined test.
4. The same horse/rider combination must perform all phases of the competition.
5. **ASTM/SEI approved protective helmets must be worn by riders at all times when mounted.**
6. Wearing of protective vests during the cross-country phase is not required, but is strongly encouraged.
7. USEA medical armbands are recommended during jumping phases but are not required.
8. Dressage test must be ridden from memory and must be ridden in approved snaffle bits.
9. Schooling in the dressage, cross-country, and stadium areas is not permitted.
10. Jumps are provided in warm-up areas and must be jumped in the direction flagged —red flags on your right.
11. Time for walking the stadium course will be provided before each division.
12. A veterinarian will be on call.
13. A farrier will be on grounds.
14. All dogs MUST be leashed while on grounds.
15. This is a non-sanctioned Horse Trials, but run in accordance with USEF/USEA rules.
16. There will be a \$25 charge for lost pinneys.
17. Food will be available on the grounds.
18. All divisions will be split junior/senior if entries permit.

I understand that a protective helmet secured with a harness/chinstrap must be worn at all times when mounted on grounds. Minors and Pony Club members must wear ASTM/SEI approved helmets. Deep Run Hunt Pony Club strongly suggests the use of Protective Vests when competing in the event. Correct safety gear may prevent serious injury to the rider.
