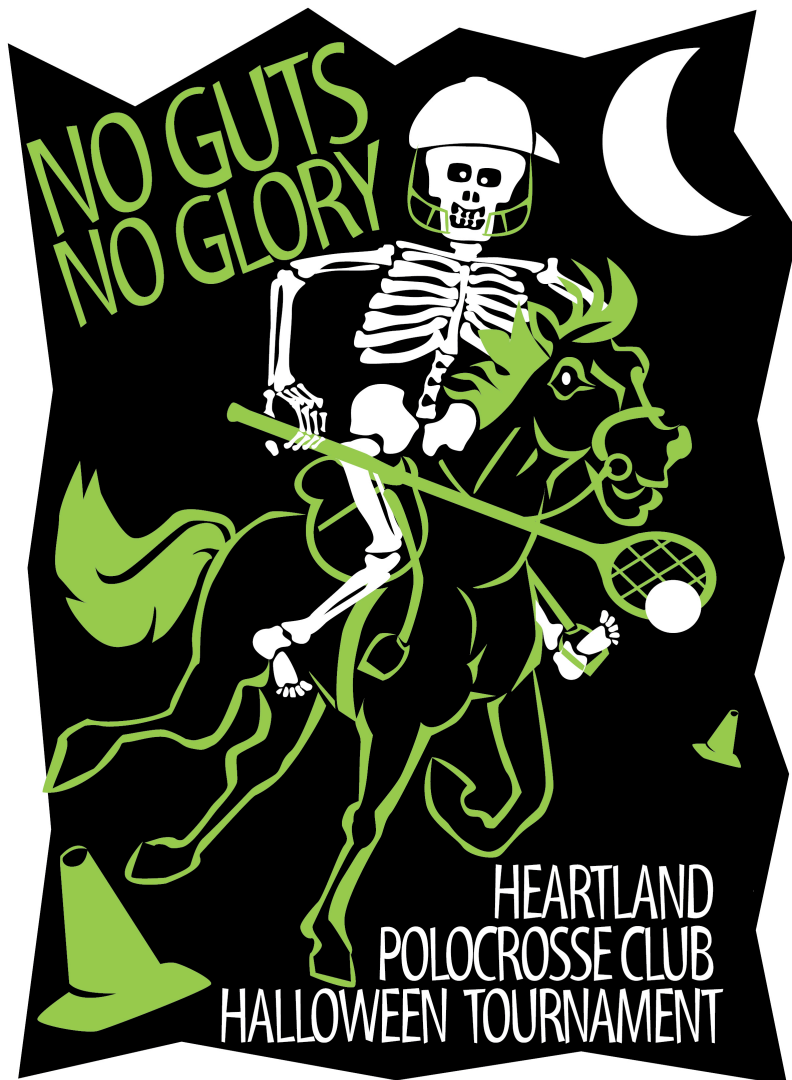
Grades A/B, C, D, E and Adult Masters divisions offered.
