Horse Management: This is a one-day trailer rally. Ponies may be tied, stalled in trailers, or hot penned.

Tents or trailers may be used for tack areas. Water for horses is available on site. Please clean up your manure and dump in designated location. Appropriate barn

footwear is required at all times.

Awards: Ribbons will be awarded to each division and to Pony Club Horse Management teams.
